\$1,000 Thomas J. Henry Leadership Scholarship Program, D: July 1, 2018 for Fall semester; Nov. 1, 2018 for Spring semester, essay should be between 750-1,000 words

Selected criteria from webpage:

“To be eligible, each student must be enrolled in, or planning to enroll in, an accredited college or university. Applicants currently enrolled in a college or university must have a minimum GPA of 2.8 to qualify for the scholarship.

The scholarship is available to all students ages 18 and over, at all levels from high school senior to graduate school.

The Scholarship Essay

To be considered for the Thomas J. Henry Leadership Scholarship, students must submit an original essay explaining the importance of leadership.

Essay Theme

The Thomas J. Henry Leadership Scholarship rewards students who show skills in motivating others inside and outside of the classroom.
