Determine the scholarship category that fits your academic status. You may only apply within one category. Students pursuing technical/vocational degrees or certificates may be eligible. See Rules & Regulations.

You may be eligible if you:

- Are a United States citizen living in the United States
- At the time of application, have applied to, have been accepted to, or are currently attending an accredited, nonprofit, two- or four-year college, university, or advanced (post-high school) vocational or technical school for academic year 2019-2020
- Have been diagnosed with and treated for a dermatologic condition
- Have been treated by a dermatologist, physician assistant, or nurse practitioner working in a dermatology practice
- Used a prescription medicine to treat your dermatologic condition*

*Applicants need not have used an Ortho Dermatologics prescription medicine. Use of an Ortho Dermatologics product will not increase an applicant's chance of being awarded a scholarship.”

- “Your application must be completed and submitted by March 1.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation are required and must be submitted by March 1. (Please give your referral enough time to submit before the application site closes).
- Your official transcripts or a copy of your official transcripts must be submitted via email or postmarked by March 1.
- High school students ONLY – if your SAT’s or ACT scores are NOT recorded on your official transcripts email or send separately to: PGSF, 301 Brush Creek Road, Warrendale, PA 15086 postmarked by March 1.
- You must have a 3.0 GPA or better.
- A full-time status. (Full-time status defined as someone who is registered in 12 or more credits per term)
- A student who is enrolled in a printing or graphic program at a technical school, college or university within the United States.
- Student must be pursuing a career in printing technology, printing management, or graphic communication.”

2019 National Association of Black Journalists (NABJ) and ESPN Stuart Scott Internship-Scholarship, D: Feb 15, 2019

Selected Criteria from Website:

“ESPN and NABJ are offering a summer internship in memory of Stuart Scott for his contributions to sports journalism. Interested students may apply for the internship online. It includes a \$3500 stipend on behalf of ESPN and the NABJ Sports Task Force.

The awardee will receive a free trip to the 2019 NABJ Convention & Career Fair in Miami. A round-trip flight, registration, lodging, and a meal stipend will be provided. He or She will be acknowledged during the Sports Task Force events and required to write a post-convention account of the experience. The awardee will also be assigned a student reporter position for the Sports Task Force website and social media channels.

NABJ’s Sports Task Force promotes diversity in America’s sports departments and provides programming toward developing future sports journalists.

Application Deadline: Friday, February 15, 2019

Candidates will be submitted to ESPN by the NABJ Sports Task Force.

ESPN Internship Program Details:

- **June 10 – August 17, 2019 located in Bristol, CT**
- **This is a paid internship – 10 weeks, 40 hours per week**
- **The student will also receive a \$3500 stipend on behalf of ESPN and The Sports Task Force.**
- **Interns will pay \$2000 for fully furnished housing that covers 10 weeks.**
- **The awardee will have the opportunity to participate in programming events hosted throughout the summer including the Intern Symposium featuring Q&A with ESPN leaders and networking with recruiters for full-time positions.**
- **The awardee will have opportunities to network with recruiters throughout the media industry for full-time positions.**
- **The awardee will be placed in a Production internship.**

Eligibility:

- **Must be an NABJ member.**
- **Must major in journalism/communications with an interest in pursuing a career in sports journalism.**
- **Must be an undergraduate or graduate student enrolled full time in the semester prior to the internship.**
- **Must be graduating in May 2019, Dec 2019 or May 2020.”**

\$5000 College Scholarships for Students with Disabilities, and Veterans and Children of Veterans, D: April 30, 2019

From webpage: “As part of our efforts to give back to our nation’s veterans, and to support the growing population of civilians who live with disabilities, we are pleased to sponsor the Marc Whitehead & Associates Law Firm **College Scholarship Program**.

Each year, our law firm awards financial scholarships to military veterans and their children, and to students with disabilities, to help them achieve their goal of furthering their education.

What College Scholarships Do We Offer?

We offer two scholarships, and each applies to post-secondary education (college or university level):

- **Frances & Earl Perry Memorial Veterans Scholarship:** An award of \$5000 will be presented to one military veteran, or a college-eligible child of a military veteran.
- **Flora Marie Jenkins Memorial Disability Scholarship:** An award of \$5000 will be presented to one non-veteran student with a disability.

Selected criteria from website:

“Scholarships up to \$20,000 over four years will be awarded to full-time students who have been accepted to an accredited four-year college, university, or equivalent (culinary school, for example). **Applicants can be current high school seniors entering college in the fall or students currently attending a college or university.**”

The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution of higher learning. Everyone who meets the requirements below is invited to apply.

Scholarship recipients will receive notice of their award by June 15 of the school year prior to when the scholarship will commence.

Scholarship Application Requirements:

- Acceptance to an accredited four-year college, university, or equivalent
- Low income household
- G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher
- Involvement in an extra-curricular activity or work
- Completion of full application including a completed **Student Aid Report** from the FAFSA or the CSS Profile
- Submit application by the March 15th deadline.
